
Instructions for downloading the certificates of participation and training from the Southern Regional Resource Center for Bilingual Education.

Enter your account and password.



Read the Privacy Policy and scroll down to the bottom of web page, then click 「Agree to receive relevant information from this website.」(同意收到本網站相關資訊,並繼續使用)



Select [Training courses]. There will be a pop-up window showing: [The data is under setting, if you need more information, please contact the officer]. Select [Check](確定).



Choose the files to be downloaded and printed (PDF), then click the Print button (列印), a new tab will be opened(Allow the pop-out window for Chrome); Each teacher will have different options in the drop-down menu, which displays the courses you have completed and passed. If the course does not appear in the menu, you have not completed it yet. Teachers can also print the certificates of participation in English or Mandarin.

Training courses

- There are three types of training courses: Physical workshops (or edited online courses) provided by regional resource centers, online courses offered by international institutions (including the OPEN Program of the US State Department, and the Certificate in EMI Skills of the Cambridge University Assessment and Examination Institute) (40 hours), and a five-day workshop organized by the British Council (BC)(35 hours).
- The OPEN Program's EMI courses, the Certificate in EMI Skills, and the BC 5-day workshops are calculated based on the study certificates given by the course providers.

Demonstration of teaching/observation of lessons

- The regional resource center will invite experts and scholars (consultant teacher) to provide teaching demonstrations/ class observation feedback.
- Teachers can request a teaching demonstration/class observation feedback by appointment through the regional resource center website system. The executions can be either physical or online (remote synchronization or video recording). After completion, the consultant teacher will submit a teaching demonstration/class observation feedback record to the regional resource center for confirmation and registration.

Teacher Community

- Teachers should participate in at least three community gatherings after joining the EMI teacher training program, the number of times can be calculated across semesters.
- After the community gatherings' participation is counted in the current certification, it cannot be accumulated again in another certification level of the EMI training program.
